

CHIP-AZ Software for Arizona School Nurses

Advisory - Microsoft Office Access 2007 Compatibility

Please read the document describing “Security Setup” for CHIP-AZ and Access 2007 available at www.CHIP-AZ.org under Microsoft Office Access 2007 Compatibility, “Security Setup”.

Learning Curve - We believe there is a significant Learning Curve before users will be able to use CHIP-AZ as efficiently in Access 2007 as they did in Access 2003. CHIP-AZ software Support is not anxious to train users how to perform known functions in the new Access 2007 interface.

What is gained by using Access 2007? – At this time we know of no performance or capability gains by using Access 2007 vs. Access 2003.

Can I use Access 2003 after Microsoft Office 2007 is installed? – Yes, however, it is suggested that Access 2003 not be uninstalled. Install Microsoft Office 2007 without including Access 2007. As long as Access 2003 is available, no changes to CHIP-AZ are required.

Technology removed Access 2003 and installed 2007. Can Access 2003 be re-installed now? I want to continue to use Access 2003. – No. Uninstall Office 2007. Microsoft strongly recommends the following installation sequence:

1. Install older version such as Access 2003 and upgrade to service patch 3 or later.
2. Next, install newer version such as Office 2007 (without Access 2007).

I still want to use Access 2007. – You will need to secure and install the Access 2007 compatible version of CHIP-AZ from www.CHIP-AZ.org Please read and follow the document under Microsoft Office Access 2007 Compatibility “[Security Setup](#)”.
