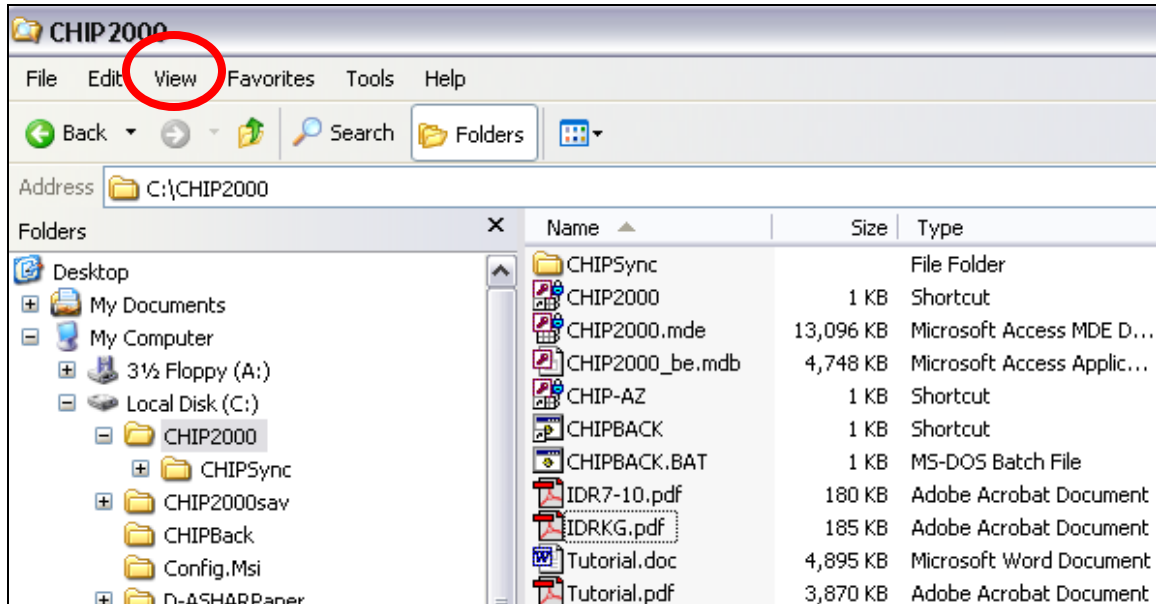


CHIP-AZ Housecleaning

Below are suggestions for files to remove and some NOT to remove.

1. Open My Computer icon on Desktop.
2. Double click C: drive
3. Double click CHIP2000 folder.
4. Click View, Details
